### RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT v2025Jan10

1. **In Consideration** of being allowed to participate in any way, in the "Maine Senior Games" and the "National Senior Games Association, Inc." program(s), its related events and activities, I, the undersigned, acknowledge, appreciate, and agree that:
  - 1.1 the risk of injury from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular skills, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist.
  - 1.2 I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation.
  - 1.3 I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the Company immediately.
2. **Publicity Release:** I hereby grant Maine Senior Games, and the National Senior Games Association Inc., the right to use my name as well as any pictures of me, (whether live or still) in connection with the activities of Maine Senior Games and National Senior Games Association, Inc. without any remuneration.
